Can-tabs fundraising

William Floyd Elementary School in Shirley hosted a kick-off event earlier this month for Can Tabs for Kids, a fundraising project of collecting aluminum tabs from cans for recycling. Participants include Holy Angels Regional School in Patchogue, Our Lady of Mercy School in Riverhead, St. Jude's Parish Outreach in Mastic Beach, and the Half Hollow Hills, Patchogue-Medford and William Floyd school districts.

Tabs are given to Gershow Recycling in Medford, which pays 55 cents per pound and will match the final sums — up to \$5,000 per school — to benefit Stony Brook University Medical Center's Sunrise Fund, which aids children with cancer.
