

Twenty-two teams from 12 fire departments participated in the tournament, which involved groups of five firefighters working to extricate a 'victim" from a "crash" using the Jaws of Life. Each team was judged on the amount of time it took to perform the extrication, the handling of equipment and the safety procedures they followed. After the tournament, the vehicles were brought back to Gershow's facility, where they were shredded and recycled.
